6 Registration /Fixture Secretary Reports

Parkside are fined as per rule, one point deducted, and as the Referee was already travelling to Rippingale, they are ordered to pay the Referee half his match fee plus travelling expenses

Blackstones v Parkside Juniors due to be played on 17th February, cancelled due to frosty pitch. Letter has been received from Parkside Juniors claiming travelling expenses for twelve cars as they felt Blackstones could have avoided them travelling. Rules state that the Referee's decision is final, and that Blackstones were perfectly in order to wait for the Referee's decision, therefore Parkside Juniors claim is dismissed

As P&T Panthers did not follow the correct procedure and enclose a stamped addressed envelope for their return they have not been processed, The General Secretary is holding them plus the £30 waiting to be collected
