- 1 The Chairman welcomed everyone and introduced Kirsty Fryer who is the Northants Development Officer
- 2 **Minutes of the last meeting;** These were agreed and duly signed.
- 3 **Matters arising;** Date to be amended to the 1st October.
- 4 **Rep Team Managers Reports;** U/14 Played their first game Milton Keynes which they won 3-1, The Peterborough squad played very well and deserved to win the game. The hospitality at Milton Keynes was excellent.

U/13 Training going very well, and played a couple of friendly games, a squad of 15 players will travel to Milton Keynes on the 25th November 1pm k.o

U/12 Squad of 14 Players selected, training going very well and played some friendlies.
- 5 **E.A.S.Y.Cup Report;** Mr Stone Reported all pitches for the Representative home games have been booked at Focus. The away fixtures at Cambridge k.o 2-30 are to be confirmed
- 6 **P.F.A. Report;** Mr Pilbeam Nothing to report, The U/13 P.F.A.Cup Draw has been re-drawn due to an administration error, Mr Redgrave to re-issue The League and Clubs. Games have had to be re-arranged due to County being on the same date
- 7 **Registration / Fixture Secretary Reports:** U/8. Letter received from the Woodston Chairman reference a Peterborough City Parents behaviour during their U/8 game. This has been sent to the Hunts F.A. who are dealing with this matter.

U/9 No Problems

U/10 Cancellation Form from Yaxley received outside the 14 day rule required to cancel fixture which was dated 19th October for game to be played on 20th October. Yaxley are fined under Rule (10r) £50 and 1 point deducted.

Bourne v Boston: Bourne Manager tried to contact the Boston Manager to confirm his League fixture for 4th November, as he could not get in touch and was going on holiday 15th Oct he left a message on the Secretaries phone. Returning from holiday 1st Nov he checked with the Boston Secretary who confirmed she had received the message and passed it on. After contacting the Boston Manager Friday Evening he said he had not had the game confirmed he had told his players he did not have a game and would not be playing Boston are fined under Rule (10p) and 1 point deducted.

U/11 Coates v Boston Fixture 4th November: Coates cancelled fixture Friday evening having 8 players missing. Coates are fined under Rule (10r) £50 and 1 point deducted.

U/12 Deeping Rangers v Oundle Juniors: Cancellation Form received outside the 14 day rule required to cancel fixture for 21st October. Oundle fined under rule (10r) £50 plus 1 point deducted. Fixture Secretary has set a new date on this game for 2nd December

Stanground Strikers v W.S.M: . Stanground Strikers cancelled fixture on morning of game they are fined under Rule (10p) £25 and 1 point deducted. They are instructed to pay the Referee fee's of £11 to the General Secretary within 14 days.

Eye United v Rippingale Rovers: Cancellation Form not received to cancel fixture for County Cup. Eye are fined under Rule (10r) and 1 point deducted. Fixture Secretary has set a new date on this game for the 2nd December

U/13 Coates named Jason Langford on their Match Result Sheet against Deaconians on the 7th October when they had not received his I.D.Card from the Registration Secretary. Coates have admitted the offence. They are fined under Rule (8t) £100 and are ordered to replay the fixture without Jason Langford.

Sawtry v Bourne: Letter received from the Referee about the Bourne Managers behaviour towards him. As this manager is also a Referee and should know better the report has been sent to the Lincs F.A.

U/14 Eye United fined for not submitting a letter for a low referee mark, Eye manager informed the General Secretary he had posted one at Gatwick Airport which had not been received, he then posted another one, but as this was received outside the three days required as per rule the fine will stand.
